

CALL FOR ABSTRACT

FAEE 2026 DOCTORAL STUDENT WORKSHOP

Dear colleagues, students,

The student chapter of the French Association for Energy Economics (FAEE) is pleased to announce its **Student Workshop 2026**, which is part of the FAEE Annual Conference 2026. The workshop will be organized and hosted by the **Grenoble Applied Economics Lab (GAEL)**, thanks to our sponsors, **GrenobleAlpes Metropole** and **Res4City**. It will take place in **Grenoble** (France) at the **Université Grenoble Alpes (UGA)** on **November 25 and 26, 2026**.

Two prizes will be awarded to the most remarkable student papers (**1000€ & 500€**). Winners will also be invited to the FAEE annual dinner. To be eligible for a prize, students must be FAEE members ([join us](#) now if this is not the case!) and be the sole or lead author of the paper. If the work is co-authored with supervisor(s), a contribution statement should be added to the paper. This statement has to outline the student's role in the paper, and confirm that the supervisors' role was primarily advisory.

If you would like to participate, you should submit an abstract first, and if selected, send a full paper (20-30 pages double-spaced) to be reviewed by an academic expert and another participant. You will have to present your paper in Grenoble in person. **Please note that you will also have to present a review of another participant's paper.** The workshop will be held in English.

Abstracts (< 250 words) should be submitted before **September 15, 2026** to faee.student@gmail.com. You will be notified of acceptance on **October 1st, 2026**. Registration should be completed before **October 10, 2026**. The full paper is due by **November 1st, 2026**.

People wishing to attend the workshop without presenting a paper can register until **November 9, 2026**. Attending the workshop is free, but registration on our website is compulsory. If you don't have an account, please create a free account [here](#).
